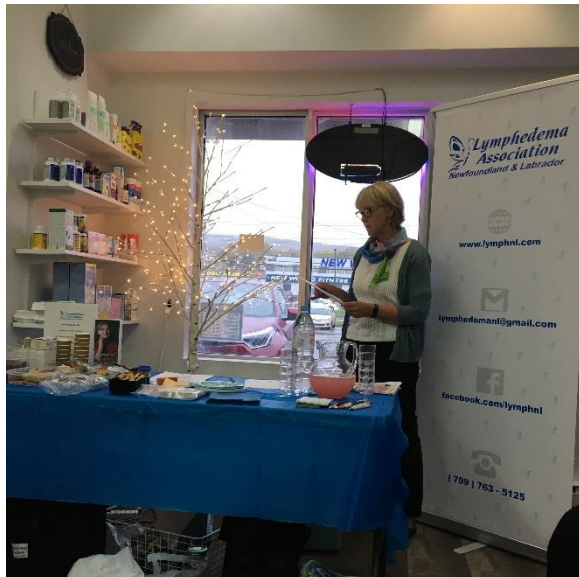

Reaching Out to More Lymphedema Patients

We've been looking for ways to reach patients in all areas of the province. While our Facebook page has been reaching quite a few, based on the statistics from around the world, we know there are a lot of people in NL with lymphedema who are undiagnosed and/or untreated. We're working with the Government of NL to have the healthcare system more aware of the disease and to have treatment more readily available.

Additionally, we've now engaged a Public relations consultant to help us organize our efforts to reach more people. Our initial meeting produced some great ideas for increasing lymphedema awareness across the province. The document we received shows that the consultant gets it: *Reaching Your Community Through Awareness & Education: Communications Strategy*. We're looking at different means of spreading awareness including how to effectively use social media.

There's a pretty steep learning curve for some of us.

Some of our commercial supporters, such as Lawton's Home Healthcare in St. John's and Corner Brook, HealthQuest, and Lemon and Lime Health Shoppe have graciously displayed the LANL banner (shown on Page 1 next to Janet) on their premises to raise awareness. When people make inquiries, they are given contact information for LANL as well as the lymphedema pamphlet produced by the Canadian Lymphedema Framework. Staff at Lawton's Home Healthcare in Corner Brook also delivered pamphlets to local physicians' offices.

Changes to the Board of Directors

Linda Burns, the Home Health Care Manager with Lawton's Drugs on Topsail Road, has resigned from the Board, due to other commitments of her time. She has been invaluable to the Board, with her knowledge of compression garments and her willingness to support all our events. Through Linda's efforts, Lawton's Home Health Care provides LANL's members with a 15% discount on compression garments and has sponsored a LANL Public Forum. We will miss Linda's contribution to the Board.

National Conference Networking

At the National Lymphedema Conference in November, there will be a networking session for the provincial associations. Again, we depend on our volunteer Board, since LANL does not fund conferences unless its continuing education for a Certified Lymphedema Therapist (CLT)!

- Community educational material delivery – pamphlets that can be left in clinics, physicians' offices and other areas in your community.
- Community organization of Aquatic Lymphatic Therapy.

With your help, we can reach lymphedema patients who may be undiagnosed or untreated, and make sure they have the information and know how to manage the disease.
